Dear Campership Donor,

Thank you for your interest in helping to send a child to Lindley G. Cook 4-H Camp. Here at L.G. Cook, we believe that *every* child deserves the chance to go to Summer Camp. Many of our campers view their week here as one of their favorites of the entire year, so being able to provide a child with one of the best weeks in a year of their childhood is a tremendous contribution. We don't take your generosity in providing this lightly, and we grateful to you for it.

Our campership policies are designed with two goals. The first, is to make it as easy as possible for you to help send a child to Camp. The second is to be sure Camp is able to cover the costs every camper entails so we can successfully continue to operate for summers and summers to come. We work to keep our registration fee for all our campers at the absolute lowest rate possible, so our campership rates are the same as our standard rate at the time of your registration.

- 1) Contact the Camp Office at 973-948-3550 and let us know you're interested in providing a Campership. All registration is online. We will need a **\$200 dollar deposit per camper week** at the time of registration. This can be paid with a check or online via card. You will receive a campership code from us to complete your registration, as Camperships are the only time we allow registration with a deposit only, and not payment in full.
- 2) All required health history and care information will be required **at the time of registration.**
- 3) Full payment must be received for the camper by **June 15th**, and all camper assignments must be finalized.
- 4) Registration changes (including changing the camper attending) may incur a \$25 dollar fee.

Again, thank you for your efforts in ensuring a camper a week at Summer Camp. As a child never forgets their week at camp, it is truly impossible to measure the magnitude if the impact you've had.
