



Summer 2022 COVID Mitigation Policies

Due to the nature of 4-H Camp's communal environment, it is highly recommended that all campers are vaccinated against COVID-19. In lieu of proof of vaccination, campers may present a negative PCR test taken within 72 hours of the start of their 4-H Camp session.



Depending on the COVID statistics in the state and recommendations from the Department of Health as summer approaches, 4-H Camp reserves the right to request a negative rapid antigen test from vaccinated campers as well.



While we are still waiting on the full Department of Health recommendations, we do not anticipate having to return to the level of on site mitigation methods (podding, distancing, outdoor meals) of Summer 2021.

As of April 4th, our standard refund policy will be in effect. (4-H Camp retains \$200 of all canceled registrations before June 15th. After June 15th, no refunds will be available. Medical exceptions will be made on a case by case basis.)
