We opened our first brand-new buildings in 40 years as we added additional staff housing and our new infirmary, which was a true summer camp game cahnger when it came to caring for our campers. The central location behind the Dining Hall and next to the bathroom was the biggest upgrade, but the new beautiful wood building with private camper sick rooms and air conditioning didn't hurt either.

Summer 2025

2025 marked the 75th Summer at 4-H Camp, and we celebrated the event with another successful sold-out camping season up here in the woods. We had 863 individual campers in attendance for a total of 1,246 "camper weeks" (including 109 campers at 4-H Camp at Rutgers Gardens and 107 campers in our 18-day Big Session.) Our team of 67 summer staff and 48 volunteer Junior Counselors helped make another summer of camp magic possible!

Our themes included:

Pirates of Lake Shawanni (self-explanatory, we think).



Broken Time Machine (you'll never guess what happened to our Time MAchine, resulting in a giant dinosaur on the dock),



We also piloted a "Little Big Session" where campers could attend the first half of our August Big Session.

November 2nd Launches Our Annual <u>Campership Campaign!</u>

The Rutgers New Jersey 4-H Camp specializes in creating tech-free, joyfully social, outdoor experiences for youth ages 8-16. It is 4-H Camp's belief that every child deserves the opportunity for this transformative summer camp experience, regardless of their financial situation.

The New Jersey 4-H Camp, with the support of the 4-H Campfire Council alumni group, is pleased to launch its third annual Campership Campaign, to raise funds for Summer 2026 and continue to help provide the summer camp experience to kids who might not afford it otherwise.

Last year, for Summer 2025, 4-H Camp gave out over \$64,000 in campership support to 84 campers for sessions at overnight camp in Stokes Forest and 4-H Camp at Rutgers Gardens. The funds raised in last year's Campership Campaign went a long way to making these 84 summer camp experiences a reality.

For Summer 2026, a generous matching donor is matching EVERY GIFT in this campaign, dollar for dollar. If we hit our \$12,500 goal, it will result in a total of \$25,000 in campership support.

100% of every donation given through the Rutgers University Foundation will go to the 4-H Camp Gift Fund, where it will be used to support the funds awarded to youth to attend Summer 2026 at the New Jersey 4-H Camp through the Campership Program.
